

## **Dr. F. Maxton “Mac” Mauney, Jr., Received Harris Award in 2003**

In 2003, F. Maxton “Max” Mauney, Jr., MD, had been named recipient of the Harris Memorial Award by The Carolinas Center for Medical Excellence (CCME), formerly Medical Review of North Carolina, Inc. Dr. Mauney was presented the award at the annual fall meeting of the North Carolina Medical Society for his outstanding achievement in the areas of leadership and service to the medical community.

In making the selection, Donald K. Wallace, MD, the then board president of CCME, said that Mauney had represented the essence of Dr. T. Reginald Harris for whom the award was named.

“Dr. Harris devoted his career to improving the quality of healthcare for Medicare beneficiaries and provided decades of service to the medical community through the North Carolina Medical Society and the American Medical Association,” Dr. Wallace had said. “Likewise, Dr. Mauney had led an exemplary life as an academic and private practice surgeon for 31 years. He had played a leadership role in health affairs on both the state and national level with a particular emphasis on devising means for quality healthcare and for health system reform. It is fitting, then, that Dr. Mauney receives the Harris Memorial Award.”
